cultural practices of victimhood aims to set the agenda for a cultural study of victimhood words such as victim and victimhood represent shifting cultural signifiers their meaning depending on the cultural context of their usage using case studies and through a practice based approach questions are asked about how victimhood is defined and constructed whether in the ritual commemoration of refugees on lampedusa the artistic practices of an aboriginal artist such as richard bell or the media practices associated with police violence consisting of contributions by cultural studies experts with an interest in victim studies this book seeks a double readership on the one hand it intends to break new ground with regards to a cultural turn in the field of criminology in particular victimology on the other hand it also seeks to open up discussions about a victimological turn in culture studies the volume invites scholars and advanced students active in both domains to reflect on victimhood in cultural practices

this book analyzes the formation of a mass anarchist movement in spain over the turn of the twentieth century in this period the movement was transformed from a dislocated collection of groups and individuals into the largest organized body of anarchists in world history the anarcho syndicalist national confederation of labour confederación nacional del trabajo cnt at the same time anarchist cultural practices became ingrained in localities across the whole of spain laying foundations which maintained the movement s popular support until the end of the spanish civil war in 1939 the book shows that grassroots print culture was central to these developments driving the development of ideology and strategy broadly defined as terrorism education and workplace organization and providing an informal structure to a movement which shunned recognized leadership and bureaucracy this study offers a rich analysis of the cultural foundations of spanish anarchism this emphasis also challenges claims that the movement was exceptional or peculiar in its formation by situating it alongside other decentralized bottom up mobilizations across historical and contemporary contexts from the radical pamphleteering culture of the english civil war to the use of social media in the arab spring

the red brigades were a far left terrorist group in italy formed in 1970 and active all through the 1980s infamous around the world for a campaign of assassinations kidnappings and bank robberies intended as a concentrated strike against the heart of the state the red brigades most notorious crime was the kidnapping and murder of italy s former prime minister aldo moro in 1978 in the late 1990s a new group of violent anticapitalist terrorists revived the name red brigades and killed a number of professors and government officials like their german counterparts in the baader meinhof group and today s violent political and religious extremists the red brigades and their actions raise a host of questions about the motivations ideologies and mind sets of people who commit horrific acts of violence in the name of a utopia in the first english edition of a book that has won critical acclaim and major prizes in italy alessandro orsini contends that the dominant logic of the red brigades was essentially eschatological focused on purifying a corrupt world through violence only through revolutionary terror brigadists believed could humanity be saved from the putrefying effects of capitalism and imperialism through a careful study of all existing documentation produced by the red brigades and of all existing scholarship on the red brigades orsini reconstructs a worldview that can be as seductive as it is horrifying orsini has devised a micro sociological theory that allows him to reconstruct the group dynamics leading to political homicide in extreme left and neonazi terrorist groups this subversive revolutionary feedback theory states that the willingness to

mete out and suffer death depends in the last analysis on how far the terrorist has been incorporated into the revolutionary sect  
 orsini makes clear that this political religious concept of historical development is central to understanding all such self styled  
 purifiers of the world from thomas müntzer s theocratic dream to pol pot s cambodian revolution all the violent purifiers of the  
 world have a clear goal to build a perfect society in which there will no longer be any sin and unhappiness and in which no  
 opposition can be allowed to upset the universal harmony orsini s book reconstructs the origins and evolution of a revolutionary
