Michel de Nostredame 14 december or 21 december 1503 2 july 1566 usually latinised to Nostradamus was a french apothecary and reputed seer who published collections of prophecies that have since become famous worldwide he is best known for his book *Les Propheties* the prophecies the first edition of which appeared in 1555 since the publication of this book which has rarely been out of print since his death Nostradamus has attracted a following that along with the popular press credits him with predicting many major world events the prophecies have in some cases been assimilated to the results of applying the alleged bible code as well as to other purported prophetic works most academic sources maintain that the associations made between world events and Nostradamus's quatrains are largely the result of misinterpretations or mistranslations sometimes deliberate or else are so tenuous as to render them useless as evidence of any genuine predictive power moreover none
